It is open to students enrolled in any STEM-based major living in the United States. All travel costs are covered by NIIMBL eXperience hosts.

Since its inception in 2019, 80 students have participated in this unique program. Students have gone on to secure internships with leading biopharma companies, including Merck, Pfizer, MilliporeSigma, and Eli Lilly.
